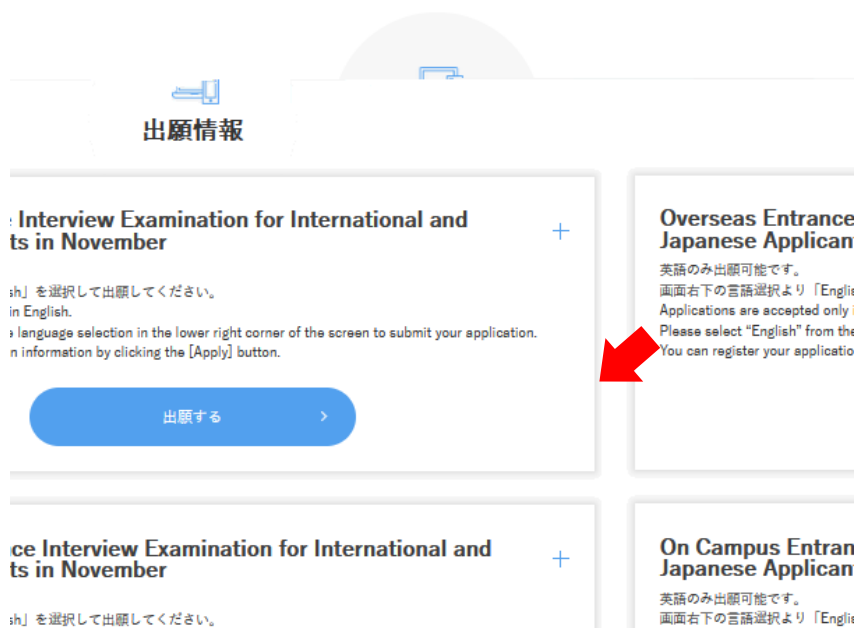
(1) Contact to the Following Email Address to get an account.
