Chapter 1 General Provisions

Purpose:

Article 1. These Regulations all prescribe matters necess to treatment of outbound exchange students and special auditors in auditors in University (hereafter, This University), based on stipulation in Paragraph 5 of Article 8, Paragraph 7 of Article 29, and Paragraph 4 of Article 30 in Hiroshimai Ventsity General Prosions (April 1, 2004 Regulation No. 2) and Article 5, Paragraph 4 in Iroshima University Graduate School Regulations (Januarly 5, 2008 Regulation No. 2).

Definitions:

- Article 2. In these Regulations, "outband exchange student" sheaffer to a student enrolled at This University who completes slassbjects at anotheniversity, etc. as a part of the curriculum at This University including a peson who studies abroad at a foreign university or junior dege (including an institution higher learning other than a university; hereafter, theoreign University, etc.), person who completes class subjects in Japan conded by an educational delity positioned as a faility that has the curriculum of a foreign university or justicollege under said feign country's school education system and designated separatelly by inister of Education, Culture Sports, Science and Technology, and earson who completes class pacts in a course at the United Nations University, teablished based on the Derder 11, 1972 United Nations General Assembly resolution stipulated in Article 1, Paragraph 2 of the Act on Special Measures (Act No. 72 of 1976) cidental to enforcement the agreement between the United Nations and Japan regard the headquarters the United Nations University (hereafter, the United Nations University)).
- (2) In these Regulations, "special auditorals in fer to a student in rolled at another university, etc. who comples class subjects at This Unisity as part of the curriculum at that university, etc.

- (3) In these Regulations, "anotheriversity, etc." shall refer ton institution falling under any of the following items.
 - [1] A university, junior college (including an advanced coser, hereafter the same shall apply), or college of technooly (including an advanceodurse; hereafter the same shall apply) that conducts a studenthange with This University
 - [2] The Foreign University, etcand educational acility positioned as facility that has the curriculum of a foreign inversity, or junior college under said breign country's school education system addedsignated separately byet Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Some and Technology
 - [3] United Nations University
- (4) In these Regulations, "inter-university contestuon" shall refer toconsultation that takes place in advance between This University the another unversity, etc.over student exchange regarding the range tass subjects that may beempleted, the number of eligible students methods of credit approxamethods of handlingues such as tuition, and other specific measures taketall be deemed necessary.
- (5) In these Regulations, "interpartmental consultation" all hrefer to consultation that takes place in advance between ools or graduatechools at This unersity (hereafter, the Schools, etc.) and the ament university, etc. over stendt exchange regarding the range of class subjects at may be completed, the number ligible students, methods of credit approval, methods be and ling fees such as twiti and other specific measures that shall be deemed necessary.

Chapter 2 Outbound Exchange Students Handling Requirements:

- Article 3. As a rule, the treatment of outbourned change students shalke place regarding matters established by inter-university cotaxion or interdepartmental consultation.
- (2) The inter-university consuttan set forth in the preceding paragraphalh be carried out by the president flowing Faculty Meetingdeliberations at a school school-related matters and Faculty Meetingeliberations at a graduatehool for graduate school-related matters (hereafter, the Relevant Faculty Meeting).
- (3) The interdepartmental consultation setriontParagraph 1 shade carried out by the dean of the relevant schoetc. following discussions by the Relevant Reculty Meeting. Application Procedure:
- Article 4. A person applyint be an outbound exchange dent must submit an application to the presideration with a prescribed application and documents filled out with information stipulated by the inter-weirsity consultation dinterdepartmental consultation.

(2) The period of application submission lsba as provided foby the interuniversity consultation or interdeptimental consultation.

Permission for Dispatch:

- Article 5. When an application to become outbound exchange student is submitted, the president shall grant permission for dispatollowing discussion by the Relevant Faculty Meeting.
- (2) When taking class subjects at another existy, etc. is approved, the president shall send the necessary documents resolutest that the presidents afid other university, etc. accept the student. Moreover, when the dispatch is assed on interdepartmental consultation, the dean of the exeant school, etc. shall requeste president of said other university, etc. to accept the student.

Study Period:

- Article 6. The study period form outbound exchange studentall be 1 semester or 1 academic year.
- (2) Notwithstanding the stipulations set foirth preceding paragorh, when unavoidable circumstances are recognize the president may change study period following discussions with the president of said another universe, etc. (in regard to interdepartmental consultation et bean of the relembershool, etc. shidhold discussions with the president of said another universe, tensually period may not exceed 2 years in total.

Inclusion in the People of Enrollment:

Article 7. The study period stipulated inethreceding article shape included in the enrollment period at This University.

Submitting a Study Completion Report:

Article 8. When the study **pie**d is concluded, an outbod exchange student must immediately (a student whousties abroad at the Foreighniversity, etc. must submit the report within 1 month terfr the day of his/her retruto Japan) submit a study completion report to the presidt through the daen of the school, et to which s/he belongs.

Tuition, etc.:

Article 9. An outbound exchangeudent shall pay the normaltion to This University.

- (2) The handling of fees such as tuition **at tuniversity**, etc. that accepts the exchange student shall be as **qui**ded for by the inter-university on sultation or interdepartmental consultation.
- (3) In accordance with the stipulations setthion the preceding pragraph, in cases where an outbound exchanguedent undertakes thereon of fees suchs tuition at the university, etc. that accepts the exchanguest, notwithstanding stipulations set

forth in Paragraph 1, the twith for This University shall rtube collected during a period to be determined by the executive (Intetional/Peace/Fund)rfeach said interuniversity consultation or interdepartmetal consultation.

Retraction of Pernsision for Dispatch:

Article 10. When an outbound change student is recognized demonstrating poor performance, manifesting input populate behavior or neglects to patuition, etc., the president may retract permissifor dispatch following discussion with the president of said another university, etc. (in regard to interdepartmental consultation, the dean of the relevant school, etchall hold discussions with the picture of said another university, etc.).

Chapter 3 Special Auditors

Applying the Handling Requirements, etc.:

- Article 11. Stipulations set fth in Article 3, Paragrapth of Article 5, Article 6, and Article 10 shall apply mutatis mutandis toesipal auditors. In this case, the phrase "outbound exchange student"athappears in Article 3, Pagnaph 1 of Article 5, Article 6, and Article 10 shall be replaced with "speaiaditor," the term "dispatch" that appears in Article 5 shall be replaced with "acceptance," article phrase "permission for dispatch" that appears in those 10 shall be changed "topermission for acceptance."
- (2) In the case set forth inethoreceding paragraph, when a signleau ditor is accepted based on the interdeptamental consultation established between the School dientistry and a foreign university, the phraste semester or 1 academic yethat appears in Article 6, Paragraph 1 shall be changed to "4 academics," and the phase "2 years" that appears in the proviso to Article 6, Ramaph 2 shall be changed to "5 years." Application Procedure:
- Article 12. A person applying toe a special auditor (excling persons applying to the Hiroshima University Morito Higher Edation Institution 3+1 Program) must submit the documents listed in the lowing items (excluding the 4 for students of other universities, etc. (excluding the Foreign University, team of the United Nations University)) to the president though the president of the university, to which s/he belongs 2 months prior to the semester in whis/he intends to study (as a rule, 6 months prior for students from the roreign University, etc.; however, when stipulations exist in the inter-university resultation or interdepartmental consultation with a Foreign University, etd., at date shall be enforced).
 - [1] The prescribed Application for Special Auditor Status for This University
 - [2] Certificate of studenstatus and transcript
 - [3] Letter of recommendation from the presidenthe university, etdo which a student belongs

[4] Certificate of health from a doctor

Notification of Acceptance:

Article 13. When a peom is granted acceptance as a spacialitor, the president shall so notify the person throughne president of the niversity, etc. to which s/he belongs.

Article 14. Cancelled

Issuance of Academic Records:

Article 15. The dean of the soul, etc. shall issue the academicords of a special auditor. Student ID Card:

Article 16. A special auditor new receive a predetermined sendID card and must always have it on his/her person.

Examination Fee, Admission Fee & Tuition:

Article 17. An examination fee dradmission fee for a specialdator shall nobe collected.

- (2) When a special auditor is a student attional university, junior college or college of technology, tuition shall not be literated at This University.
- (3) When a special auditor is a student pathalic or private university, junior college, college of technology, a Feeign University, etcor the United Natins University, s/he must pay a tuition of 14,800 tyteby a predetermined date fearch class equivalent to 1 credit taken in a semester stissemester or second semielystellowever, when any of the following items apply, payment tuition is not required.
 - [1] When the tuition for said student is earned mutually non-dectible through an inter-university credit exchange agreem that has been concluded with a public or private university, junior code, or college of technology
 - [2] When the tuition for said student is the mutually non-dectible through an inter-university exchange agreement, indepartmental exchange agreement, or the equivalent that has been not luded with the Foreign University, etc. or the United Nations University
- (4) Notwithstanding the stipulans of the preceding paragraphhen the special auditor is a student accepted based or nater-university exchange agreement for the Hiroshima University Morito Higher Education Instition 3+1 Program, tution for the following items must be paid by a prediction date in accordance when period of completion.

1. Term 3: 399,600 yen

2. Term 4: 532,800 yen

(5) Tuition that has already the paid shall not be refunded.

Burden of Fees:

Article 18. Fees required r laboratory work and praical training shall be the responsibility of the specialuditor, as appropriate.

Chapter 4 Miscellaneous Provisions

Miscellaneous Provisions:

- Article 19. In addition to the regulations prescribed hereatters necessary to the implementation of these **Bel**ations shall be presided by the schools, etc.
- (2) In addition to the regulations prescribed, matters necessate the treatment of special auditors for the Hiroshima University Morito Higher Education Institution 3+1 Program shall be separately prescribed.

Supplementary Provisions

- 1. This regulation shatome into effect from April 1, 2004.
- 2. When this regulation comes into effectudents who have the granted outbound exchange student or special auditor states on the form thiroshima University Exchange Student Regulations (Hiroshidnaiversity Regulations of 1972 Regulation No. 32) shall be regarded lassving been grantleoutbound exchange udent and special auditor status in accordant with this regulation.

Supplementary Provisions (Ail 1, 2005 Regulation No. 30)

This regulation shall come interfect from April 1, 2005.

Supplementary Provisions (Derober 20, 2005 Regulation No. 138)

This regulation shall come interfect from December 20, 250 and stipulations set forth in the Hiroshima University Student Excharing gulations revised in accordance with this regulation shall be apply from December 1, 2005.

This regulation shall come inteffect from April 1, 2008.
