AdSM Grant for Taking an English Proficiency Test in the Academic Year 2020 (2020 年度 英語能力検定受験料支援制度について)

To AdSM Master s and Doctoral Students,

The Graduate School of Advanced Sciences of Matter (AdSM) offers grant for taking English proficiency test, the TOEIC® test in principle. The grant aims at improving student English skills to further promote participation in international academic conferences, research activities and international exchanges by using AdSM financial support systems such as AdSM Grant for Overseas Research Activities of Master's and Doctoral Students. We will accept applications for the grant as shown below.

1. Application Eligibility

Applicants must be master s or doctoral students at AdSM.

2. Tests Applicable for the Grant

In principle, the TOEIC® official test, but other English proficiency tests are also applicable.

3. Application Requirements and Amount of the Grant

- 1) One person is allowed to make an application for this grant TWICE an academic year.
- 2) The maximum amount of the grant is 5,500 yen for one application. It will be paid after taking the test.

*If you make an application for the TOEIC® official test at Hiroshima University CO-OP shop, the test fee will be a discounted price, 5,390 yen. If you make an application at other places or on the Internet, the test fee will be 6,490 yen and 990 yen will be student s own responsibility.

4. Term for the Grant

From April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2021 (1 academic year)

5. How to Apply

Please fill out an application form, attach the receipt of test fee and get a confirmation seal from your supervisor. Submit the application form with the receipt and reimbursement invoice(立替払請求書) form to AdSM Student Support Office by 6. Application Deadline $.(9:00 \sim 12:00, 13:00 \sim 17:00)$

These forms can be downloaded from the AdSM website- Student Financial Support.

After taking the test, submit the score certificate to AdSM Student Support Office. The grant will be paid after the score certificate is submitted.

6. Application Deadline

Application form, reciept and reimbursement invoice form: last weekday before the test (Applications after taking test will not be accepted.)

Score certificate should be submitted within one week after you receive it.
