## **Course registration procedures for Common Graduate Courses**

Students who are enrolled at the following graduate schools are required to take at least one (1) credit from each of course categories, "Sustainable Development Courses" and "Career Development and Data Literacy Courses".

- Graduate School of Integrated Sciences for Life (Doctoral Course)
- Graduate School of Biomedical and Health Sciences (Doctoral Course)
- Graduate School of Humanities and Social Sciences (Doctoral Course)
- Graduate School of Advanced Science and Engineering (Doctoral Course)
- 1. Course registration should be done via "My MOMIJI" during the designated registration period.

- 2. The number of courses that can be registered in each semester (1st [Spring] and 2nd [Fall]) is one (1) for each of the "Sustainable Development Courses" and "Career Development and Data Literacy Courses" category. (Note, however, that this restriction is not applicable to "Long-term internship".)
- 3. Each course sets an enrollment limit. Therefore, if the number of applicants exceeds the limit, students who can attend the course will be selected by computerized random draw to be held during the adjustment period. Note that, depending on the drawing result, students may be restricted from the course registration procedures as shown below during the period of confirmation and correction for the registered courses.

If the registration is accepted by the drawing	If students are allowed to attend the course as a result of the drawing, they cannot cancel the registration without any special reason. If there is such special reason for canceling it, contact the office below.	
If the registration is <b>NOT</b> accepted by the drawing	Students can register for another course. However, only courses for which the drawing has not been held and which have not reached the enrollment limit can be registered for. <b>Note that the registration will be conducted on a first-come-first-served basis</b> .	

- 4. Please check syllabus carefully before the course registration because some courses include overstay-training held on-site (outside campus). The course list can be seen on "View syllabus" page of My MOMIJI by searching for "Common Graduate Courses (Doctoral Course)" in "Faculty/Graduate School" field.
- 5. On-demand classes will apply to students without easy commuting access to regular classrooms in order to provide an opportunity for them to take these classes. If you wish to take an on-demand course, please make sure that you fall under any of the conditions in the syllabus and contact the support office of your degree program or the office below.

## [Important Note]

Doctoral students who are enrolled at <u>the other graduate schools</u> are also allowed to take the Common Graduate Courses (for Doctoral Course). However, the credits earned from those courses will NOT be counted for graduation requirements.
