3	(High alert) (Extensive restrictions)	*Online classes only.	*Only research staff who are currently conducting research/experiments that are difficult to stop are permitted to enter their laboratories with the utmost consideration to prevent the spread of infection. *Only those who are indispensable for continuing research (see ※1) may enter the laboratories concerned.	*About half of the administrative members are required to telework by taking shifts with the other members who are commuting to their workplaces as usual.	*Conduct online meetings as much as possible.	*The entry of undergraduate and graduate students, in general, is prohibited (see ※2)	*All extracurricular activities are prohibited, except for certain activities that require the care of living organisms.
4	(Severe alert) (Maximum restrictions)	*Online classes for all the students (access to the internet should be made from home). *Keep the number of teaching staff on campus to bare minimum.	*All the research activities are prohibited, except those that are directly related to the novel coronavirus counter-measures. *Students are not allowed to enter their laboratories. *Only those who are indispensable for maintaining the laboratory assets (see ※1) may enter the laboratories concerned.	*Only the bare minimum number of the administrative members commute to their workplaces to maintain the functions of their offices. The rest of the members should work from home (i.e. telework).	Video-conferencing only	*Entry to the campus by any undergraduate, graduate students and researchers etc. is all prohibited (see ※2)	*All extracurricular activities are prohibited, except for certain activities that require looking-after of living organisms.
5	(Emergency) (Bare minimum required activity)	*Online classes for all the students (access to the internet should be made from home). *Teaching staff conduct online classes from home.	*Entry to all the research laboratories is prohibited. *Only those who are indispensable for maintaining the laboratory assets (see ※1) may enter the laboratories concerned.	*Only maintenance personnel may commute to the campus and work. The afore-mentioned activities restriction index may be subject to change according to the circumstances regarding the spread of infection from this point of time onwards.

(※1) Those who engage in essential research activities and lab assets maintenance (taking care of living organisms, replenishing liquid nitrogen, etc.) must obtain permissions from the respective graduate school's dean or research center director in advance. (Application form in Japanese)

(※2) The following individuals are not subject to the restrictions above: those who have registered in advance to attend the online classes on campus due to a lack of network connectivity at home.
