If you plan to write your master's thesis in Japanese, however, consult with your academic advisor.</p> <p>2. To demonstrate your English proficiency, you are required to submit one of the following documents:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Score report of TOEFL® test (your total score must be at least 85 [iBT conversion]) • Score report of TOEIC® Listening & Reading Test (your total score must be at least 780) • Score report of IELTSTM (your overall band score must be at least 6) <p>If your score does not meet the above requirement, consult with your prospective academic advisor. The academic advisor will then evaluate whether you have the proficiency required for admission through an interview or application documents.</p> |
| | International Economic Development Program | <p>After completing the term as a research student, you must have sufficient English proficiency to enroll in a degree program and complete your degree within the standard period of study.</p> |
| | International Education Development Program | <p>Your prospective academic advisor will evaluate whether you have sufficient language proficiency required for admission through an interview or application documents. There are no language proficiency requirements in this program. You must however submit a document that demonstrates your language proficiency to your prospective academic advisor.</p> |
