The "Hiroshima University Faculty Mentor System" was introduced in April 2020 to provide appropriate support to faculty members after their arrival at the university without isolating them, and to help them smoothly start various activities such as education, research, and administration. The mentoring system is unique among national university corporations in that it assigns multiple mentors to each faculty member.

What is the MENTOR SYSTEM

The mentor system is an individual-focused support activity conducted by those with a certain degree of work experience (mentors) for those with little experience (mentees). Along with helping resolve issues in career development, it also assists personal growth by providing support to help resolve worries and problems in the workplace.
