The Program of History educates students to be able to understand historical characteristics of Japan, Asia, and Europe, as well as global relationships between those countries and regions, in addition to conducting history research from a comprehensive and multifaceted point of view.

For the field of Japanese History, the Program offers subjects regarding ancient, medieval, early modern, and modern Japanese history to allow students to learn research methods for each era.

For the field of Asian History, the Program offers subject such as pre-modern and modern Chinese history, and Southeast-Asian history, Central Eurasian History to allow students to learn specialized research methods for each area.

For the field of Western history, the Program offers subjects regarding the ancient Mediterranean world, medieval European history, and modern European history to allow students to learn research methods for each era and region.

- (2) To acquire the ability to formulate new ideas bas historical materials, while following the results and methodologies of established research in their respective fields such as Japanese history, Asian history, and Western history; and
- (3) To furt international point of view and thinking skills, as well as the ability to collect and analyze materials and data, the

ability to think logically and creativity, and the skills to make discussion presentations.

To be awarded a degree after completing the curriculum in this Program, which is designed to attain these goals, students are required to meet the following conditions:

- (1) Students shall be enrolled in this Program for a prescribed period, and shall acquire the prescribed number of credits by completing class subjects set by this Program, and
- (2) Students shall develop a deep insight into human culture through the collection, analysis, and critical consideration of sourcebooks and historical materials, and shall prepare and submit their own theses.
- 4. Curriculum policies (Policies for organizing & providing curricula)

This Program organizes and implements the following curricula to achieve the educational principles and educational goals of the School of Letters, as well as to attain the goals of this Program:

- (1) Students shall take liberal arts education subjects to acquire a broad education that provides the basis for specialized research, foreign language abilities, information processing ability, and a broad perspective on human problems such as peace-related problems in an interdisciplinary fashion,
- (2) Students shall be assigned to the educational program & the field of expertise in the second year, and shall take subjects for specialized lectures to acquire a basic knowledge and understanding on their respective fields of expertise,
- (3) Students shall take participatory and small-class subjects for specialized seminars (such as basic seminars and advanced seminars) in the third year to acquire the ability to comprehend the source materials, the ability to investigate materials, research methods, and the ability to perform logical analysis, and
- (4) Students shall refine their creative and multifaceted analytical abilities under the guidance of faculty members in their fourth year, and after deciding on the theme of their theses, shall prepare their graduation theses as a compilation of their studies in the Bachelor Program.

- Note 1: The term indicated with a circle represents the term in which students typically take the subject. If a student fails to earn the credit in that term (or semester), they are allowed to take the subject in a later term (or semester). Students are required to confirm the semester in which the subject is provided in the class schedule for liberal arts education subjects that is published for every academic year, as some subjects may be provided in another term (or semester) than that which is provided in this document.
- Note 2: Students are required to earn 4 credits for 2 subjects or more in the natural sciences and 4 credits for 2 subjects or more in the human & social sciences.
- Note 3: When the student takes a subject of Advanced Seminar, Health and Sports Courses, Social Cooperation Courses or Foundation Courses, the credit(s) is considered to be for Area Courses.
- Note 4: For English language studies and Non-English Foreign Languages, achievement in Foreign Languages skill test might be accepted as a credit. For further details, refer to "Foreign Languages" and "Credit based on Achievement in Foreign Language Skill Test" in the section for liberal arts education.
- Note 5: The credits of Area course and Social Cooperation course in English, which are gained more than required, could be counted as credits of English subjects.
- Note 6: Students are required to earn 2 credits for either Basic English Usage I, II or Intensive Studies I, II. Those who want to study foreign languages(excluding English) futher are recommended to take Intensive studies I, II. If students earn more credits of them than the number of credits required, the exceeded credit(s) up to 2 credits is considered to be for Area Courses.
- Note 7: For Information and Data Science studies, students are required to take the subject "Introduction to Informtion and Data Sciences" that is provided in the second term, and to earn 2 credits in the subjects of "Computer Programming "," Intelligence and Computer", "Foundamental Data Science", "Starting Programming from Scratch" and "Data science for education". If students earn more credits of them than the number of credits required, the exceeded credit(s) up to 2 credits is considered to be for Area Courses.
- Note 8: Students who want to obtain an educational personnel certification are required to earn 2 credits for the subject "Japanese Constitution" in Area Courses, 2 credits for the subject "Introduction to Information and Data Sciences" in Information and Data science Courses, and 2 credits in Health and Sports Courses. For the detail, refer to "Acquisition of Educational Personnel Certification" in the section for the specialized education.
