1. Aims of this Grant

2. Details of the grant

1) About 300,000 yen per assignment.

(However, the amount may be reduced depending on the number of adopted cases.)

2) An undergraduate student from the School of Applied Biological Science can apply as a representative, but in the case, it is necessary to include a faculty member from the School of Applied Biological Science as a co-investigator.

(Undergraduates applying as representatives are not allowed to apply for graduation theses.)

3) The use of the grant is limited to faculty members of School of Applied Biological Science.
