Center for Global Partnership CGP mission (common tasks)

Targeting executives of domestic and foreign companies, central government ministries, and local government, PCGL develops an educational curriculum responding urgent issues. In addition, PCGL conducts a wide range of short-term training (e.g. executive education, recurrent education, summer courses) in English for students and society. (Executive Training)

In addition to centrally managing and operating our university's diverse global internships (overseas internships for our students and domestic internships for international students), PCGL plans and implement new global internships. (Global Internship)

Building and strengthening relationships with United Nations related international organizations whose mission is to respond to global issues, PCGL sends faculty and staff to international organizations on a medium to long term basis. (Dispatch to International Organizations)

Chief Peacebuilding Officer

Positions of Chief Sustainability Officer and Global Internship Coordinator have been decided.

- (1) As Chief Peacebuilding Officer, **lead** university-wide initiatives that contribute to the realization of a free and peaceful society, and also strive to ensure that various university activities such as education, research, and social contribution become practices toward the realization of a free and peaceful society. Further, **carry out** comprehensive planning, coordination, and evaluation, and also **conduct** the educational research necessary for these purposes.
- (2) **Be in charge of** the Hiroshima University FE/SDGs Network Center (NERPS) and **participate** in its efforts as Chief Peacebuilding Officer.
- (3) As Chief Peacebuilding Officer, support the efforts of the SDGs initiatives promoted by Hiroshima University.

- (4) **Carry out** work (executive training, global internships, dispatch to international organizations) to achieve the mission of CGP.
- (5) **Constantly upgrade** the transdisciplinary programs developed at the Graduate School of Innovation and Practice for Smart Society to new programs based on social needs, **plan**, and **implement** certificate courses, and **develop** them into degree programs.
- (6) **Write** academic papers (to be published in SCI) related to the above activities.
