# Housing

Students are guaranteed University-owned housing if they request housing on their application and apply for their specific choices by the deadline. Students can choose from the University housing options listed below or find their own housing off campus.

## Yudof

Fully furnished apartment-style accommodation located on campus. All units have a kitchen or kitchenette. No meal plan is required.

## Centennial

Traditional dormitory-style accommodation located on campus. Students can live in a single or shared room, and share a common bathroom with other units. A meal plan is required, as there are no kitchens.
