Most courses are taught in Korean, but a variety of courses are offered in English. The list of courses taught in English will be available one or two months prior to each semester. The list will be sent to all accepted exchange students by email with instructions on course registration. Exchange students can take up to 18 academic credits per semester. If students would like to learn Korean language, they can participate in the Korean Language Program during the semester at a discounted price.
