Students coming to Germany will have to apply for a student visa via the Germany embassy in their home countries. The visa process might take up to six weeks . After arrival in Muenster, students from Non-EU countries with a stay longer than 3 months <u>have to apply for a residence permit</u> (costs about 100 €). Detailed information will be sent to all incoming exchange students. |
