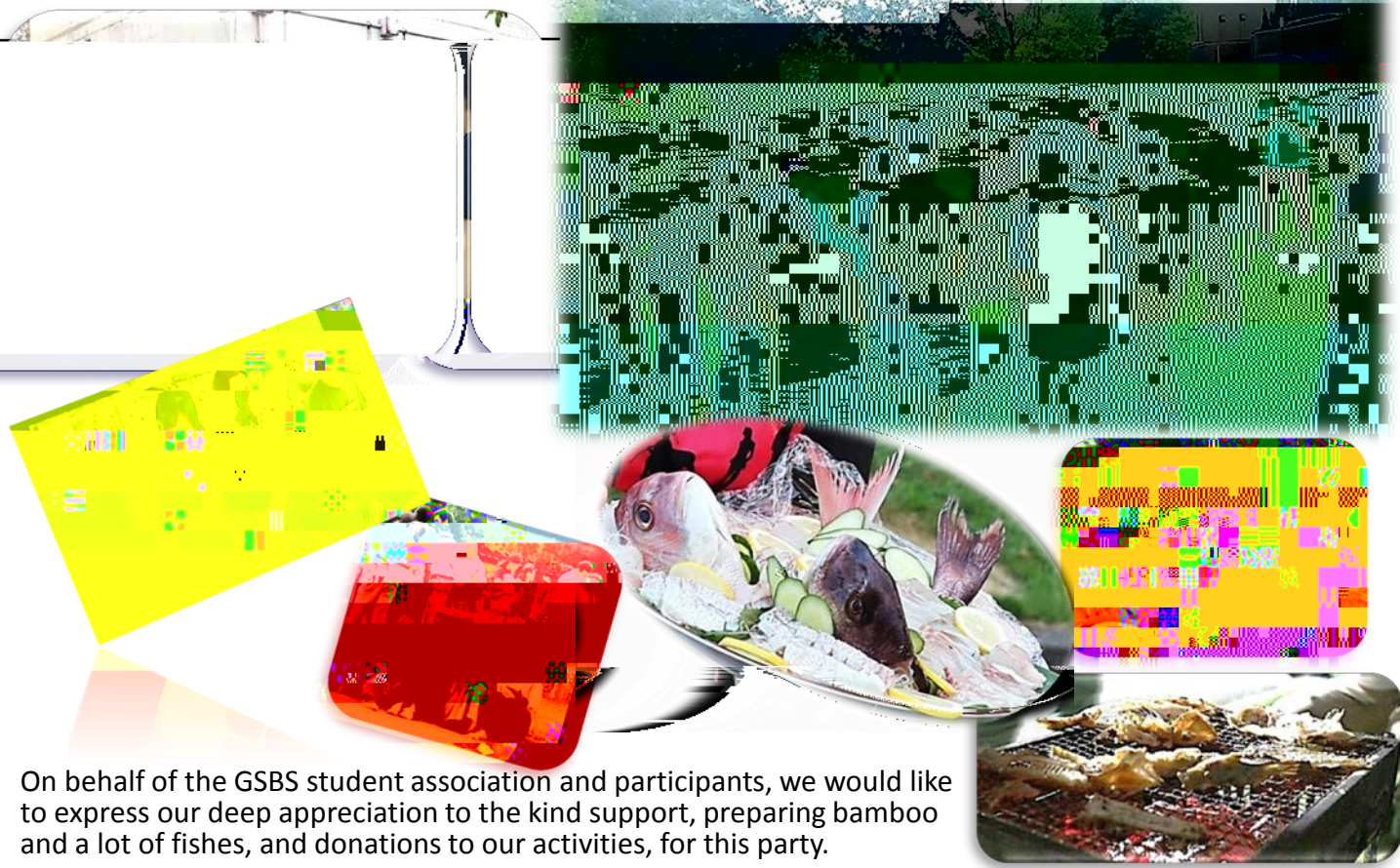
The main events were:
