### ● Contents of Abstracts

The word limit for abstracts is 300 words. Titles, authors and authors' affiliation are not included in the 300 word limit. Please avoid abbreviations. The abstract must contain a brief statement of:

1) background and rationale, 2) hypothesis or study objective 3) design and experimental methods used, 4) essential results, and 5) conclusion

### ● Presentations

The poster area will be 180 cm high by 90 cm wide. Your display should include your "program number" of the abstract, title, authors and affiliations. Actual poster presentation time is 1 hour, 12:00-13:00, November 8 (Sunday). A "Presenters" ribbon must be picked up on site for you to wear during the meeting. You are required to stay at your poster for the presentation time. No audio-visual equipment is used.

### ● Competition

Competition is planned. A shield on which Liquidambar styraciflua, an emblem of Hiroshima University Faculty of Dentistry, is drawn will be presented to an excellent poster presenter.
