Academy of Hiroshima University (Institute of Biomedical & Health Sciences)

- 2. Position and the Number of Opening: associate professor, one (1)
- 3. Date of Appointment: August 1, 2017(or later, as soon as possible)
- 4. Period of Employment: Five (5) years (Tenure-track position)
  - \* No reappointment or extension of employment will be offered. However, tenure-track faculty members will undergo a tenure review within six (6) months prior to completion of the term of appointment, and those who have successfully passed the review process will be granted tenure
- 5. Field of Specialization: Health Sciences, International Health and Medical Care
- 6. Teaching Responsibilities
  - <u>Undergraduate level</u>: Lectures, practices, and clinical practices on sites (including overseas) in international health and medical care, English in medical/health sciences, and public health/epidemiology/preventive medicine at Faculty of Medicine and other Facilities. Interprofessional education (IPE) carried out in collaboration with Faculty of Medicine and related subjects.
  - Graduate level (both Master's program and Doctoral Program): Lectures, practices, and clinical practices on sites (including overseas) in international health and medical care, and public health/epidemiology/preventive medicine at Graduate School of Biomedical & Health Sciences and other graduate schools. Lectures in Research Methodologies in Health Sciences, tutorial in English academic paper writing and presentation. Education for aid to developing countries from health science perspectives
  - \* All of above must be provided in English. You are requested to take a coordinator position of the Graduate courses for English speaking students.
  - \* In addition to the courses listed above, he or she may be asked to teach other general education courses and/or discipline specific courses in other department(s) and graduate school(s).

Applicants must satisfy all of the following qualifications.

- (1) Holding a doctoral degree in Medicine or Health Science-related
- (2) Holding a national license in medical area Countries which issued the license is not limited to Japan
- (3) Being able to give lectures and academic supervision at the graduate level in English
- (4) Preferably having job experiences at International agencies and/or organizations (or related activities)
- (5) Applicants who possess Japanese nationality must meet at least one of following conditions
  - 1) Holding a degree conferred by a foreign university or institution
  - 2) Having teaching or research experiences (except experiences as student) at foreign universities or educational institutions for 1 year or more in total
