Hiroshima University aims to become one of the global top 100 universities by continuously producing global talents and creating knowledge while promoting university reforms centering on the twin pillars of educational and research capabilities.

Graduate School of Biomedical & Health Sciences, Hiroshima University invites applications for one assistant professor position. We are seeking candidates who can play a key role in the training of medicinal scientists, contribute effectively to make the Drug Discovery & Biomarker Center more successful in the field of Neuropharmacology, especially for pain, which we are all fully committed to advancing, and enhance our global presence.

1. Affiliation (Appointment):

2. Position and the Number of Opening: Assistant Professor (tenure-track), one (1)

3. Date of Appointment: February 1, 2018

* Be sure to be able to arrive by March 31, 2018.

4. Period of Employment: Five (5) years

* No reappointment or extension of employment will be offered. However, tenure-track faculty members will undergo a tenure review within six (6) months prior to completion of the term of appointment, and those who have successfully passed the review process will be granted tenure.

5. Field of Specialization: Nerve pain pharmacology

6. Teaching Responsibilities

- Undergraduate level (general education courses): Introductory Seminar for First-Year Students, etc.
 - Undergraduate level (discipline specific courses): Pharmacology related courses, practice and thesis, etc.
 - Graduate level: Pharmacology related courses and practice, etc.
- * In addition to the courses listed above, he or she may be asked to teach other general education courses and/or discipline specific courses in other departments and graduate schools.

7. Application Requirements

Applicants must satisfy all of the following qualification.

- (1) Be under 35 years old as of March 31, 2018.
- (2) Hold a doctorate or an equivalent degree by the time the appointment begins
- (3) Be able to supervise doctoral students in preparation of doctoral dissertations
- (4) Have experience in supervising graduate students in a master's and/or doctoral program(s) in preparation of thesis/dissertation
- (5) Be able to teach classes and supervise students in English
- (6) Close to native-level proficiency in the English language
- (7) Have lived in Japan for one or more years before the scheduled date of commencement of employment

8. Application Documents

- (1) Recommendation letter (Self-recommendation is allowed.) (Free format)
- (2) Curriculum Vitae (Form 1)
- (3) List of Achievements (Form 2)
- (4) Summary of 5 Major Publications (Free format)
Write a summary of the above 5 major publications in either Japanese (approximately 2000 characters), or English (approximately 1000 words).
- (5) Aspirations for Pharmaceutical Education and Research (Free format)
Write your aspirations for pharmaceutical education, research and how to contribute for pharmaceutical science in either Japanese (approximately 2000 characters), or English (approximately 1000 words).
- (6) Reprints or photocopies of 5 major publications

11. Selection Procedures

- (1) Selection will be made based on all application documents submitted.
- (2) Interviews will be conducted as needed. As a general rule, we will conduct simulated lessons in English. In such cases, please note that travel expenses will be the responsibility of the applicant. Applicants who pass the initial document review will be informed of interview date, time and format.
- (3) Hiroshima University promotes a gender-equal society in accordance with the legislative intent of the Basic Law for a Gender-Equal Society.

12. Salary, etc.

- (1) The annual salary system will be applied to successful candidates.
(Regulations Concerning Salaries of Hiroshima University Faculty Members Employed under Annual Salary System will be applied.)
- (2) Successful candidates may be reimbursed for travel expenses incurred for the trip from their home or former place of work to the new place of work to assume their post in accordance with the relevant regulations of Hiroshima University. For more information, please contact us.

13. Evaluation

We conduct individual performance evaluations for all Hiroshima University faculty members after their employment, numerically rate their performance, and salary and benefits are commensurate with performance indicators.

14. Additional Remarks

- (1) Personal information obtained from application documents will not be used or provided to any third parties for purposes other than the necessary procedures related to personnel affairs, salary, and welfare.

- (2) All the faculty members of Hiroshima University belong to the "Academy", which is the single university-wide faculty organization, and each faculty as a member of the Academy of the University is appointed to educational and/or research organizations such as an individual undergraduate school, and graduate school.
- (3) During the first fiscal year, about 2,000,000 yen will be provided to each Assistant Professor as a start-up fund.
- (4) This open recruitment is conducted as an assistance program for Promoting the Reform of National Universities, The Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT).
- (5) Hiroshima University facilitates the adoption of foreign faculty members (those who are nationals of a country other than Japan) with the aim of promoting globalization of the university.
